We accept all types of artwork with no media restrictions. A monetary prize will be awarded to one student in each grade level at a public event, date TBD. Winners do not have to be present to receive their prize.

Theme: April 22, 2020 marks the 50th Anniversary of Earth Day, and in honor of that, TA&H is participating in the "Billion Acts of Green" campaign. We encourage students to create work out of natural, recycled, upcycled, or repurposed materials, or for the imagery to relate to loving this planet we call home.

The Student Art Show will go live at www.TietonArts.org Saturday, April 25 and continue through June 30. Entries will be accepted beginning April 6. There is no cost to participate.

Artwork Specifications:

- No medium or size restrictions, but if work is over 4 ft or 30 lbs please let us know!
- If you can, wrap artwork in paper or plastic to protect it. We will rewrap at the end of the show upon return.
- Limit to one entry per student.
- Each work must have the registration form attached.
- Group projects are encouraged!
- Works on paper will be hung with binder clips or magnets, while framed works or works on stretcher bars will be hung with nails or screws. Pedestals/shelves for sculptures will be provided.
